**Melody Makers is aimed at children in Y1-4 and will be based around musical games, singing, boomwhackers, body percussion and classroom percussion instruments.**

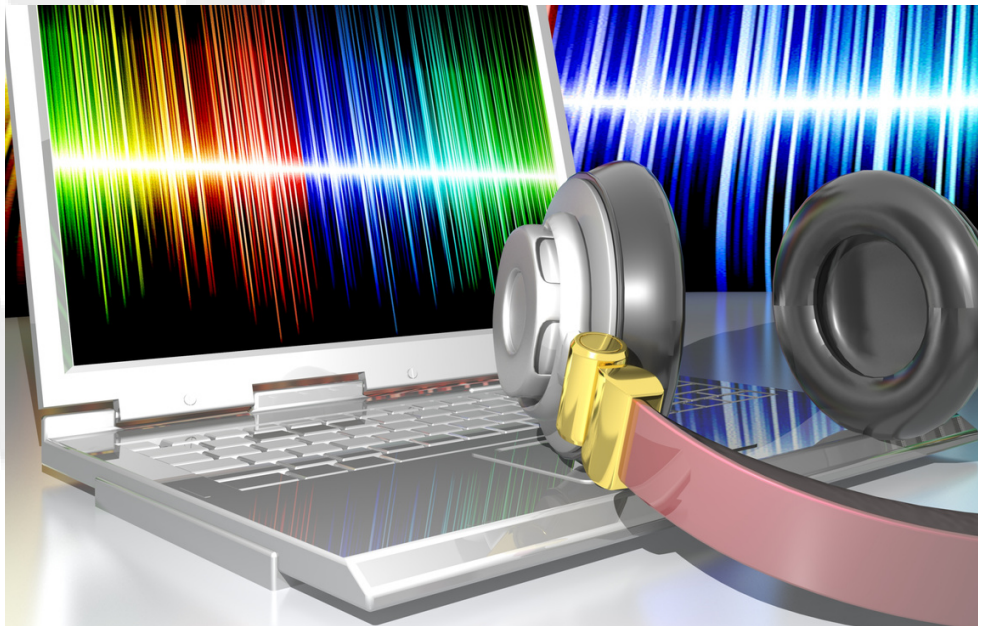


# M:TECH

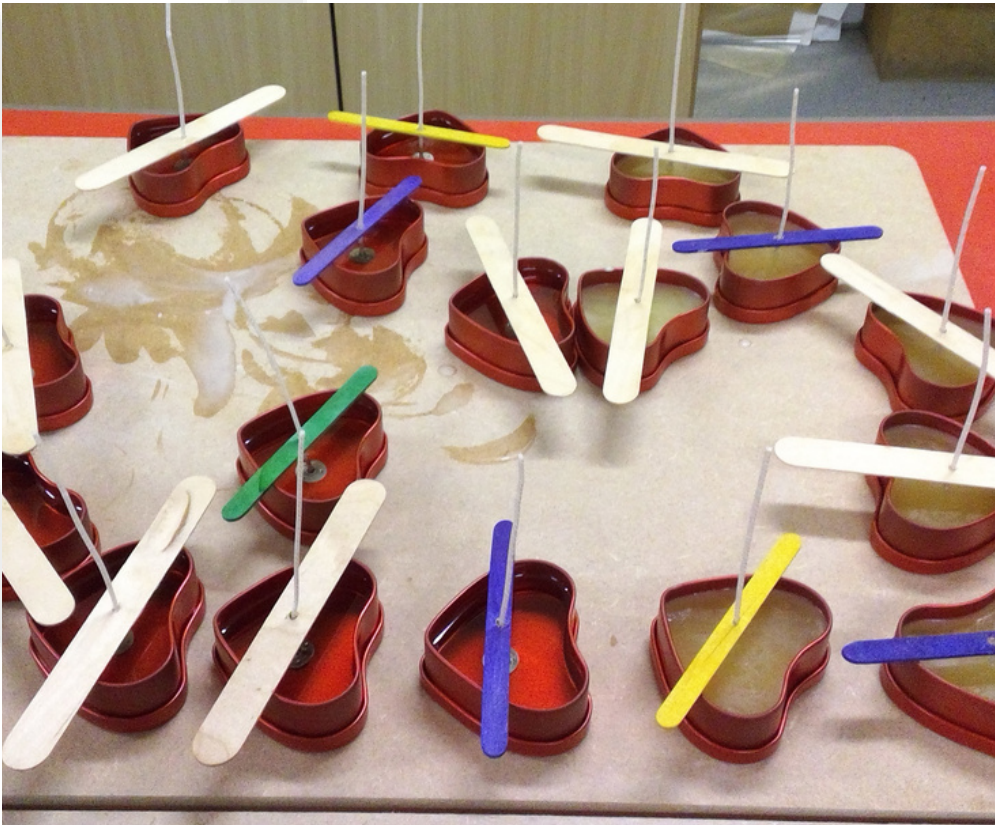




# YOUNG FARMERS MARKET
