

A GCSE Grade 7 in Maths and Science to study Biology, Chemistry or Physics

A GCSE Grade 7 in Maths to study Maths, and Grade 8 to study Further Maths

A GCSE Grade 6 or above, or in a supporting subject for all other subjects.
